Free Parking

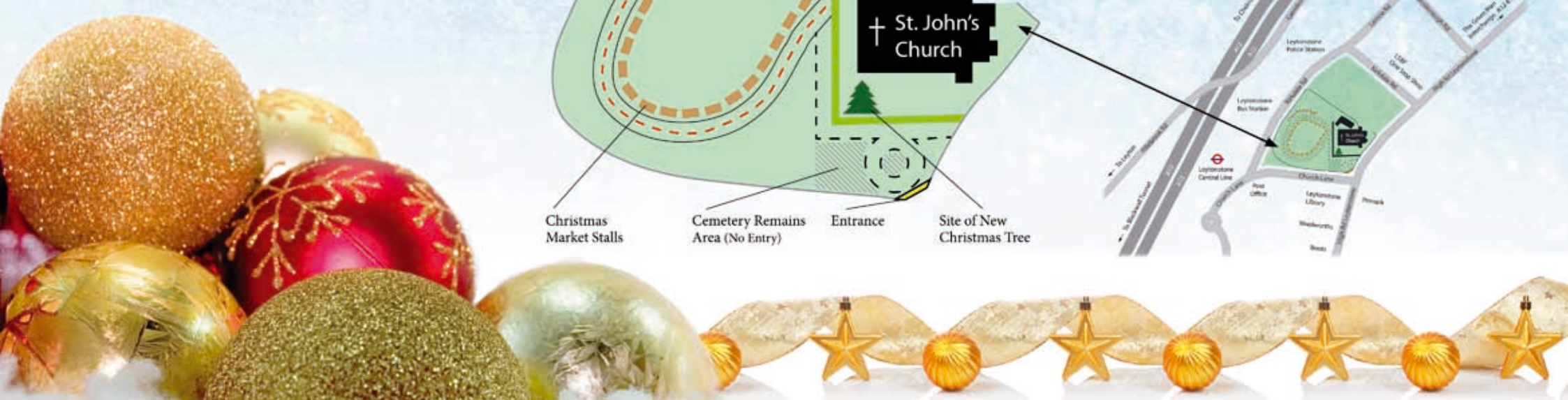
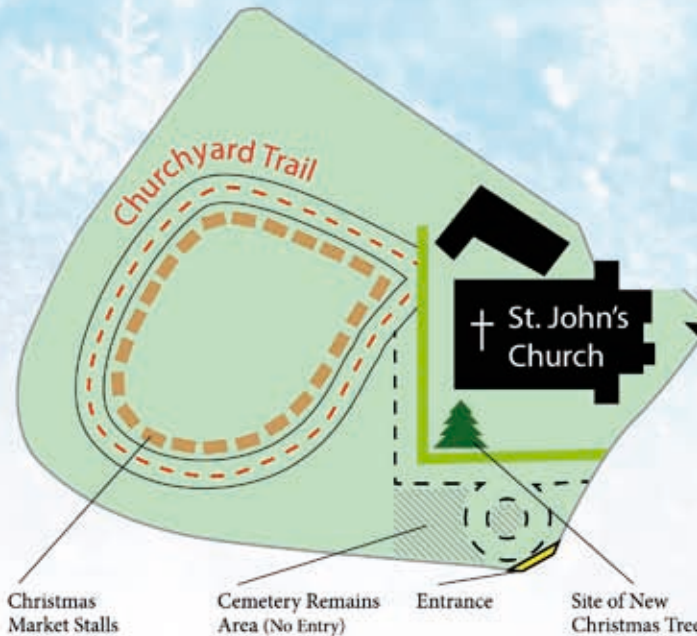
